In continuation to this office letter of even number dated 19.11.2025 on the subject noted above, it is clarified that the students aspiring for admission to Allied and Healthcare professional courses after passing of senior secondary level equivalent exam, in **some of the undergraduate Allied and Healthcare courses NEET appearance requires as a basic eligibility criterion** along with other eligibility criteria. The course specific eligibility may be confirmed from the Commission's website.
